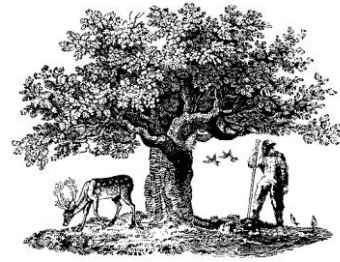


QUIET CORNER ENVIRONMENTAL WORKSHOPS AT YALE MYERS FOREST



Wednesday, June 13th Land use history of the Yale-Myers Forest workshop

The workshop will start at 8 am at the Yale-Myers Forest Camp, 150 Centre Pike, Eastford, CT. This is a one hour 15 minute drive from New Haven. The workshop will cover the indigenous and colonial history of the forest with a lecture and discussion. This is followed by site visits in the field to various historical land uses within the forest. Please bring plenty of water to drink, snacks to eat, and a packed lunch.

Friday, June 15th Breeding Bird Diversity and Abundance - Workshop on Habitat Management - Yale-Myers Forest

This workshop is an introduction to the taxonomy, ecology and diversity and abundance of breeding birds in the Yale-Myers Forest. The workshop especially is focused on the relation of habitat type and silvicultural treatment to within and across stand (landscape scale) forest age-class and structure. The workshop will be held at the Yale-Myers Camp, 150 Centre Pike, Eastford, CT starting at 7.30 am and finishing at 4.00 pm. Bring snacks, plenty of water to drink, a packed lunch and come prepared to walk in the woods.

Directions to Yale Myers Camp: From New Haven, take I91N to I84E to Exit 71, left off the ramp and straight through 2 stop signs and 2 blinking stop lights, onto a dirt road and then back to pavement for ~1.75 miles, look for orange gate on left.
